



TEAM BASICS

Communication:

We use the **Groupme** App. This is how all information is sent out to the group. There is a private chat feature in Groupme where you can speak to someone directly. If the whole team does not need to know, please do not post in the Groupme. Private Chat Ms. Silviya directly. If you are running late to practice, please call the front office because the coaches do not often check their phones during practices.

Facebook: We do have a **Facebook page** for Leaps & Bounds Diamonds Acro Team but we do not use it for regular communication. It's for the general public. We also have a **Facebook group** for the Acro that is just for current parents. It is mostly used for sharing pictures and videos but not need to know information.

Communicating with Silviya. She is diligent in working on better communications with the parents. Written communication via Groupme Chat or Email is preferred. She has apps that she uses to help translate intricate communication. She has one that you can speak into and it converts to Bulgarian so that there are no miscommunications when speaking face to face. The kids are able to use these resources as well. Please be patient and work with her as she is the person who can best help your child. If you are having any trouble communicating, please contact your team mom or the front office.

Social & Digital Media: We ask that all social media concerning Acro Team, Leaps & Bounds, its staff and customers be done in a positive manner.

Conflicts:

Tuition: 6-12 hour/wk (Due the 1st of the month) tuition prices on next page

HOW WILL PRACTICES WORK?

This season we are trying a new approach to

practice times. Coach Silviya will be putting the athletes

SUBJECT TO CHANGE** together in pair/groups, and we will have a meeting to where each pair/group will have the opportunity to pick practice times that work best for everyone. We will have practice time options with so many slots in each to allow to keep student teacher ratios and successful practices happening. Once practice schedule is put together, it will stay the same for the remainder of season, will not change each month. More will be explained about this after try-outs, at the first parent meeting. Practices for June & July will be scheduled as normal.

TUITION

Within the levels, the pair/groups will have the opportunity to pick how many hours of practice they want, and tuition will apply accordingly. Each Level is given a minimum amount of practice time (shown in the previous page), but if want to pay for and attend more practice, that option is available.




